### BEZEQ GROUP REPORTS THIRD QUARTER 2008 FINANCIAL RESULTS

Net profit attributable to shareholders increased 81.2% year-over-year to a record NIS 462 million, on record revenues of NIS 3.16 billion

EBITDA increased 19.6% year-over-year to a record NIS 1.25 billion

Free cash flow increased 30.9% year-over-year to NIS 653 million

**Tel Aviv, Israel – November 25, 2008** – Bezeq The Israel Telecommunication Corp., Limited (TASE: BEZQ), Israel's leading telecommunications provider, announced today its financial results for the third quarter 2008, the period ended September 30, 2008. Details regarding today's investor conference call and web cast are included later in this press release.

#### Bezeg Group Third Quarter 2008 Financial Highlights:

- Revenues of NIS 3.16 billion, up 0.6% compared to the prior year period.
- Operating profit totaled NIS 822 million, up 37.9% compared to the prior year period.
- Net profit attributable to shareholders totaled NIS 462 million, up 81.2% compared to the prior year period.
- Earnings per basic and diluted shares amounted to NIS 0.18 and NIS 0.17, respectively, compared to NIS 0.10 and NIS 0.09, respectively, for the prior year period.
- Earnings before interest, taxes, depreciation and amortization (EBITDA) totaled NIS 1.25 billion, up 19.6% compared to the prior year period.
- EBITDA margin was 39.4% compared to 33.2% in prior year period.
- Gross capital expenditures totaled NIS 595 million, up 79.2% year-over-year.
- Free cash flow totaled NIS 653 million, an increase of 30.9% year-over-year and an increase of 57.0% sequentially.

#### **Divisional Highlights:**

- Bezeq Fixed-Line: Fixed-Line segment results were highlighted by a 29.1% year-over-year increase in operating profit to NIS 422 million, and a 13.0% increase in EBITDA to NIS 636 million. Segment EBITDA margin totaled 45.8% for the quarter. Improved profitability continued to be driven by the positive impact of streamlining and efficiency efforts that have begun to yield significant benefits to the segment and Group.
- Pelephone: Pelephone's mobile operations delivered double-digit year-over-year growth in operating profit, net profit and EBITDA, as revenues rose 0.9%. EBITDA reached NIS 422 million, yielding an EBITDA margin of 34.8%. Results were driven by the strength of Pelephone's 3G subscriber growth (1.07 million total 3G subscribers as of September 30, 2008), which helped push total cellular subscribers up to approximately 2.70 million, an increase of 5.4% year-over-year, and by lower subscriber acquisition costs.
- **Bezeq International**: Operating profit increased 9.3% year-over-year to NIS 59 million and net profit increased 12.8% to NIS 44 million, driven by higher sales of core segment services including broadband Internet, outgoing international calls, as well as the

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continued strength in demand for enterprise integration solutions. EBITDA reached NIS 79 million, up 5.3% year-over-year, reflecting an EBITDA margin of 24.0%.

• yes: Multi-channel pay-TV revenue increased 4.2% year-over-year to NIS 375 million driven by a 2.7% improvement in ARPU to NIS 226 and a 2.0% increase in subscribers to 556,000. EBITDA reached NIS 111 million, up 79.0% year-over-year, reflecting an EBITDA margin of 29.6%.

Shlomo Rodav, Chairman of the Board of Bezeq, stated, "Our record third quarter group financial results reflect our successful execution across operating segments and reaffirm Bezeq's position as Israel's leading communications provider. Bezeq's performance was driven by year-over-year revenue growth in our Pelephone, Bezeq International and yes business segments while our Fixed-Line segment outperformed by reporting revenues roughly in line with the year ago period, when excluding the impact of cellular interconnect fees. Our streamlining and cost efficiency measures implemented in our Fixed-Line business continued to yield measurable improvements in our cost structure, helping drive record Group operating profit, net profit and EBITDA results," concluded Mr. Rodav.

Alan Gelman, Chief Financial Officer and Deputy CEO of Bezeq, commented, "Based on our solid financial results in the third quarter, Bezeq generated its strongest free cash flow performance in almost two years. The strength of our operating cash flows and balance sheet provide a strong foundation for us to execute on our network investments while, if and when decided by the board of directors, continuing to return value to our shareholders through periodic dividend distributions. We continue to position Bezeq for future growth by investing in several key communications infrastructure developments, including our HSPA cellular network which is expected to become operational during the first quarter of 2009, and the initial development of our Next Generation Network (NGN) where we are currently working to complete our two initial district deployments.

"While we are continuing to actively monitor the global and local economic environment, we saw no material impact from the recent economic and financial events on our business in the third quarter of 2008. We continue to expect Group-wide full-year 2008 revenues to remain stable and margins to improve as compared to 2007," concluded Mr. Gelman.

Bezeq Group's revenues for the third quarter of 2008 were NIS 3.16 billion, up 0.6% from NIS 3.14 billion reported for the third quarter of 2007. Higher revenues were driven by increased sales in Pelephone cellular and yes multi-channel television segments, which were partially offset by a decrease in the domestic Fixed-Line communications segment. Continued growth in high speed Internet and data communications services at Bezeq's Fixed-Line segment mitigated the anticipated decline in revenue associated with fixed-line telephony.

Operating profit for the Group increased 37.9% year-over-year to NIS 822 million, up from NIS 596 million in the year ago period, and was driven mainly by cost reduction, lower cellular subscriber acquisition cost, and streamlining initiatives in our major operating segments.

The Group's earnings before interest, taxes, depreciation and amortization (EBITDA) for the third quarter of 2008 were approximately NIS 1.25 billion (39.4% EBITDA margin), up 19.6% as compared to the third quarter of 2007 (33.2% EBITDA margin).

Net profit attributed to Bezeq shareholders amounted to NIS 462 million in the third quarter of 2008, up 81.2% compared with the NIS 255 million reported in the third quarter of 2007.

Net capital expenditures amounted to NIS 581 million in the third quarter of 2008, an increase of 84.4% compared to the third quarter of 2007, mainly due to the ongoing deployment of Pelephone's HSPA network, as compared to the same period of 2007.

The Bezeq Group's free cash flow totaled NIS 653 million in the third quarter of 2008, an increase of 30.9% compared to the third quarter of 2007. The increase in free cash flow was primarily the result of significantly higher cash flows from operations, which were partially offset by the anticipated increase in net capital expenditures. The increase in operating cash flow was mainly driven by working capital improvements in our Fixed-Line segment.

As of September 30, 2008, the Group's net financial debt was NIS 4.96 billion, compared with NIS 4.79 billion as of September 30, 2007.

Bezeq Fixed-Line's primary objectives remain to compensate for the predictable erosion in domestic telephony revenues with growing revenues from broadband Internet and value-added services, and solutions for the business segment, as well as reducing costs. While revenues posted a modest decline year-over-year, the segment posted significant improvements in operating profit and EBITDA.

Revenue from fixed-line domestic communications declined 2.6% to NIS 1.39 billion in the third quarter of 2008 compared to NIS 1.43 billion in the third quarter of 2007. The decrease in Fixed-Line revenue was mainly due to a decrease in interconnect fees to the cellular networks as well as a decrease in the number of lines due to increased competition, a reduction in call traffic and a decrease in tariffs. The decrease in revenue was moderated mainly by higher levels of revenues generated from subscriber growth in high-speed Internet access services (ADSL) and from sales of home networks, as well as an increase in data communication services.

When adjusted for revenues from cellular airtime collected by Bezeq and paid to the cellular companies, Bezeq Fixed-Line's revenues reached NIS 1.16 billion, roughly stable year-over-year. This continues to demonstrate Bezeq's ability to compensate for the decline in legacy telephony revenues through growing advanced services and solutions offered to the consumer and business markets.

The number of customers subscribing to Bezeq's high-speed Internet service (ADSL) rose 5.5% year-over-year to 994,000 as of September 30, 2008. Bezeq continued to upgrade its ADSL subscriber base, with 38% of it already enjoying bandwidths of at least 2.5 MB, as compared to 17% in the prior year period.

The growth in Bezeq's ADSL customer base helped offset a 4.4% decline in total telephony access lines during the same period which totaled 2.65 million as of September 30, 2008. The pace of decline in telephony access lines slowed to 36,000 lines during the third quarter of 2008, down from a quarterly average of 40,000 lines lost during the first half of 2008.

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ADSL ARPU in the third quarter was NIS 67.3, up 6.0% from the prior year period, while fixed-line telephony ARPL declined 1.9% year-over-year to NIS 84.3.

Bezeq's Fixed-Line segment posted positive EBITDA of NIS 636 million (45.8% EBITDA margin) in the third quarter of 2008, compared to NIS 563 million (39.5% EBITDA margin) in the third quarter of 2007. This significant improvement was driven by an 11.9% decline in salary expense, and an 8.8% reduction in general and operating expenses. These performance gains reflect the ongoing success of cost-cutting and efficiency measures that have been taken in this segment over the past year.

During the third quarter the company initiated its Next Generation Network (NGN) project, including two operational district deployments. Bezeq's NGN will provide broadband download speeds of up to 50 MB and innovative value-added services, and will allow for the achievement of further efficiencies in our operating structure. The fiber-to-the-curb (FTTC) project is being deployed on a modular basis, and the Company will evaluate the continuation of each stage on an annual basis.

Pelephone generated double-digit percentage improvements year-over-year in operating profit, net profit and EBITDA performance driven by higher revenues resulting from subscriber growth, higher revenues related to data, content and value added services, and lower subscriber acquisition costs.

As of September 30, 2008, Pelephone had approximately 2.70 million active subscribers, an increase of 5.4% year-over-year, and added 62,000 net subscribers from the second quarter of 2008. Pelephone remains the market leader in Israeli 3G subscribers with a record 1.07 million 3G subscribers as of September 30, 2008, representing approximately 40% of all Pelephone subscribers. Revenues from data and value added and content services constituted 16.2% of revenues from cellular services in the third quarter, compared to 15.5% in the previous quarter of this year and 12.8% in the year ago period.

Pelephone's revenues increased 0.9% year-over-year to NIS 1.21 billion in the third quarter of 2008. The rise is mainly attributable to an increase in the number of subscribers, which was

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partially offset by a decrease in average revenue per user, mainly due to erosion of tariffs for outgoing calls and a decrease in interconnect fees.

Pelephone posted positive EBITDA of NIS 422 million (34.8% EBITDA margin) in the third quarter of 2008, compared to NIS 340 million (28.3% EBITDA margin) in the third quarter of 2007. Pelephone's net profit in the third quarter of 2008 increased 37.0% year-over-year to NIS 211 million.

During the third quarter Pelephone progressed with the deployment of its new HSPA network infrastructure and currently expects this network to be operational during the first quarter of 2009. The HSPA network initiative is central to Pelephone's commitment to access higher value segments of the mobile communications market.

Bezeq International, Israel's leading supplier of Internet services and direct-dial international calls, posted third quarter 2008 segment revenue of NIS 329 million, up 0.9% compared to the third quarter of 2007. This increase was driven by higher revenue from Bezeq International's core business areas, including Internet broadband service, outgoing international calls and enterprise integration solutions. Gains in these areas were partially offset by a decline in hubbing traffic between foreign operators using Bezeq International's switching equipment.

Bezeq International posted a record EBITDA of NIS 79 million (24.0% EBITDA margin) in the third quarter of 2008, up 5.3% compared to NIS 75 million (23.0% EBITDA margin) in the third quarter of 2007.

Bezeq International generated an operating profit of NIS 59 million and a net profit of NIS 44 million in the third quarter of 2008, up 9.3% and 12.8%, respectively, year-over-year. The increase in profitability came as a result of growth in core business areas, combined with a decrease in general and operating expenses.

Revenue from the yes multi-channel pay-TV segment increased 4.2% to NIS 375 million in the third quarter of 2008 from NIS 360 million in the year ago period. The increase in revenue was primarily related to a 2.7% year-over-year increase in ARPU to NIS 226 as well as a 2.0% net increase in subscribers.

yes posted positive EBITDA of NIS 111 million (29.6% EBITDA margin) in the third quarter of 2008 as compared to EBITDA of NIS 62 million (17.2% EBITDA margin) in the third quarter of 2007. As a reminder, during the second half of 2007 yes experienced a temporary reduction in revenues and increase in expenses related to a disruption of broadcasting services.

The net loss in the third quarter of 2008 totaled NIS 82 million compared to net income of NIS 70 million in the third quarter of 2007. Net income in the year ago period benefited from a NIS 213 million favorable impact related to non-cash financing expenses. Net financing expenses during the third quarter of 2007 were positively influenced by a recalculation of the fair value of shareholders' loans due to the postponement of expected payment dates; as a result, yes recorded net financing income.

yes maintained its 37% market share with 556,000 subscribers as of September 30, 2008, up 11,000 subscribers from the year ago period and up from 551,000 as of June 30, 2008.

#### Outlook

Based on current business conditions, Bezeq continues to expect Group-wide full-year 2008 revenues to remain stable, reflecting the combination of continued erosion in domestic fixed-line telephony with growth across the rest of the business segments. In addition, the Company expects to continue focusing on reducing costs and expanding margins. Regarding Group level gross capital expenditures, in 2008 the Company is reiterating its forecast for an increase of approximately 50% year-over-year mainly due to the deployment of Pelephone's HSPA network infrastructure as well as the initial stages of the company's NGN project.
